SWWC Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Diamond Water Company ("Diamond Water") and SWWC Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Water Services, Inc. ("Water Services") files its Proof of Notice by Affidavit and states as follows;

SWWC Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Diamond Water Company ("Diamond Water") and SWWC Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Water Services, Inc. ("Water Services") filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Bandera, Comal, and Gillespie Counties on July 21, 2016 with the Public Utility Commission of Texas. Under 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24:112(c)(1) ("TAC") and Texas Water Code § 13.301, notice to customers, affected municipalities and the Office of Public Utility Counsel ("OPUC") of an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights shall be made by mail, email or hand delivery. On July 21, 2016, SWWC Utilities, Inc. provided to OPUC by hand delivery a copy of its application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights. Lastly, SWWC Utilities, Inc. mailed notice to all customers and affected municipalities on August 26, 2016, meeting all the necessary requirements under TAC 24.22(c)(1). has submitted an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to purchase all water facilities and to transfer water service area under CCN No. 12865, in Bandera, Comal, and Gillespie_Counties, TX from:

SWWC Utilities, Inc. dba Diamond Water Company 12535 Reed Road Sugarland, TX 77478 (Seller's or Transferor's Name) (Address) (City) (State) (Zip Code)

The sale is scheduled to take place as approved by the Commission (V.T.C.A., Water Code § 13.301). The transaction and the transfer of the CCN includes the following subdivision: <u>River Bend Estates</u>, <u>Enchanted River Estates</u>, <u>Oakview</u>, <u>Kestrel Airpark</u>, <u>Windmill Ranch</u>, <u>Rim Rock Ranch</u>.

The areas subject to this transaction are:

BANDERA COUNTY

Enchanted River Estates is located approximately 2 miles west of downtown Bandera, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by SR 16; on the east by Tobin Ranch Rd; on the south by Bottle Springs Rd; and on the west by at the intersection of SR 16 and Enchanted River Rd extending south to Bottle Springs Rd. The total proposed area being requested includes approximately 164 acres and 113 current customers.

River Bend Estates is located approximately 2 miles west of downtown Bandera, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by SR 16; on the east by Medina River; on the south by Medina River; and on the west by Medina River. The total proposed area being requested includes approximately 151 acres and 93 current customers.

COMAL COUNTY

Windmill Estates/ Kestrel Airpark is located partly in, and north of, <u>Bulverde</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Stealth Rd</u>; on the east by <u>U.S. Highway 281</u>; on the south by <u>State Highway 46</u>; and on the west by <u>Ahern Creek Rd</u>. The total proposed area being requested includes approximately <u>571</u> acres and <u>221</u> current customers.

Rim Rock Ranch is located east of, and adjacent to, <u>Bulverde</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Smithson Valley Rd</u>; on the east by <u>Rustling Ridge</u>; on the south by <u>FM 1863</u>; and on the west by <u>Longhorn Trail</u>. The total proposed area being requested includes approximately 1200 acres and 328 current customers.

GILLESPIE COUNTY

Oakview Water System is located approximately 7 miles south/southeast of downtown Fredericksburg, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by S. 290; on the east by Cain City Rd; on the south by Cain City Rd and Luckenbach Rd; and on the west by Old San Antonio Rd. The total proposed area being requested includes approximately 170 acres and 63 current customers.

This transaction will have the following effect on the current customers' rates and services: <u>Current customer rates will remain the same</u>, service quality will remain the same, and SWWC Utilities, Inc. service policies and fees will remain the same.

Affected persons may file written protests and/or request a public hearing within 30 days of this notice.

To request a hearing, you must:

- (1) state your name, mailing address and daytime telephone number;
- (2) state the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application;
- (3) the statement "I/we request a public hearing";
- (4) write a brief description of how you, the persons you represent, or the public interest would be adversely affected by the proposed transaction and transfer of the CCN; and
- (5) state your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Only those persons who submit a written request to be notified of a hearing will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

Persons who wish to intervene or comment should file a request in writing within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice with:

A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, Commission will not transfer the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
