COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION THAT NOTICE BE FOUND SUFFICIENT AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE BE ADOPTED

Comes now the staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this response to Order No. 2. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. Background

On August 23, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge issued Order No. 2, requiring Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice provided within 14 days of the Applicants filing proof of completed notice with the Commission. The Applicants filed proof of notice on September 1, 2016. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. Notice Sufficiency

Staff has reviewed the Applicants' proof of notice and, as supported by the attached memorandum from Emily Sears in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, recommends that the provided notice be found sufficient. Applicants provided notice to the entities required by Order No. 2 and recommended in Staff's Memorandum filed August 19, 2016.

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III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

IV. Conclusion

For the reasons detailed above and in the attached Staff Memorandum, Staff respectfully recommends that the notice be deemed sufficient. Staff also recommends that the procedural schedule proposed above be adopted.

On July 21, 2016, SWWC Utilities Inc. dba Water Services, Inc. (Purchaser) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to purchase facilities and transfer and cancel all of water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12865 of SWWC Utilities, Inc. dba Diamond Water Company (seller) (collectively, Applicants), in Bandera, Comal, and Gillespie Counties, Texas pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann (TWC), §§ 13.301 and the 16 Tex. Admin Code (TAC) §§ 24.109 and 24.112.

Staff reviewed the information provided by the Applicants in response to Order No. 2. The notice was provided to current customers, neighboring systems, cities, other affected parties in Bandera, Comal, and Gillespie Counties on August 26, 2016. Affidavit of notice was filed by the Applicants on September 1, 2016, and was sufficient.
