**ORDER NO. 4**  
**APPROVING SALE AND TRANSFER TRANSACTION TO PROCEED**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's November 9, 2016 recommendation that the transaction between John Frias Waste Water Utility and Olmito Water Supply Corporation, Inc. should be allowed to proceed. Commission Staff further recommends that applicants be required to promptly provide the final sale documents and documentation that deposits have been properly handled.

The sale/transfer transaction between John Frias Waste Water Utility and Olmito Water Supply Corporation, Inc. may proceed and be consummated. As soon as possible after the effective date of the transaction, but not later than 30 days after the effective date of the transaction, applicants shall file proof that the sale/transfer has been consummated and customer deposits addressed. Applicants have one year to complete the transaction. If the transaction is not consummated within this period, or an extension granted, this approval is void and applicants will have to reapply for approval of the sale.<sup>1</sup> Applicants are advised that the water facilities of John Frias Waste Water Utility will continue to be held by John Frias Waste Water Utility until the sale and transfer transaction is complete in accordance with the Commission's rules.

Beginning **December 15, 2016**, and continuing monthly thereafter, applicants shall file monthly updates regarding the status of the sale/transfer.

Within 30 days following the filing of applicants' proof that the sale/transfer has been consummated and customer deposits (if any) have been addressed, Commission Staff shall file a


