# ORDER NO. 1 REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATION

### I. Application

On July 22, 2016, John Frias Waste Water Utility and Olmito Water Supply Corporation, Inc. filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Cameron County. Specifically, Olmito WSC seeks approval to acquire all of the sewer system assets of John Frias held under sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20714. The total area being requested includes approximately 36 acres and serves 79 current customers.

## II. Establishing Deadline for Commission Staff's Recommendation

Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a) (TAC), Commission Staff shall file, on or before **August 22, 2016**, comments/recommendation regarding administrative completeness of this application, whether additional notice may be required to comply with the applicable procedural rules, and propose a schedule for processing.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission will submit notice of this application for publication in the *Texas Register* on August 5, 2016.

#### **Filings** III.

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission filing clerk.<sup>2</sup> A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties.<sup>3</sup> All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange, http://interchange.puc.texas.gov.

All parties shall provide their current addresses, telephone and facsimile numbers, if available, to all other parties and the Commission by filing and serving all parties with such information. Each party shall provide the Commission and all parties with updated address, telephone, and facsimile information if such information changes. The telephone and facsimile numbers will be placed on the service list for this proceeding. Parties are responsible for updating their own service lists to reflect changed information and the addition of any other parties.

### **Ex Parte Communications** IV.

Ex parte communications with the administrative law judges and presiding officer (collectively, ALJs) are prohibited.<sup>4</sup> Parties shall communicate with the ALJs only through written documents filed with the Commission's Filing Clerk and served on all parties. Questions concerning this order or any other order must be submitted in writing, filed with the Commission, and served on all parties of record.
