COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas, representing the public interest, and files Commission Staff's Response to Order No. 1 and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 22, 2015, John Frias Waste Water Utility (Frias) and Olmito Water Supply Corporation (Olmito) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of certificate rights in Cameron County. Applicants seek approval of a sale, transfer or merger in which Olmito will acquire all of Frias's certificated service area under sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20714 in Cameron County. and associated facilities. Olmito's CCN would be amended. There are 79 customers.

On July 26, 2016, in Order No. 1, the Commission administrative law judge (ALJ) directed Staff to file, on or before August 22, 2016, a recommendation regarding administrative completeness of this application, comments on whether additional notice may be required to comply with the applicable procedural rules, and propose a schedule for processing. Staff's recommendation regarding sufficiency of the application and notice is therefore timely filed.

II. COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS OF APPLICATION

Staff has reviewed the application and recommends that the application be found administratively complete in accordance with Tex. Water Code Ann. § 13.246 and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.106 (TAC). Furthermore, 16 TAC § 24.105 provides the Commission's requirements for CCN applications, and 16 TAC § 24.106 provides the Commission's notice requirements for

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CCN applications. Staff has reviewed the application and based on the attached memorandum (Attachment A) from Fred Bednarski of the Water Utilities Regulation Division, Staff recommends the application be deemed administratively complete and recommends that the application be accepted for filing. Staff also recommends that the Applicant be instructed to issue notice. Attachment A provides instructions for the Applicant regarding notice. Attachment B provides sample notice.

III. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEUDLE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

On July 22, 2016, Olmito Water Supply Corporation, (Purchaser or Olmito), Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20784, and John Frias, (Seller or Frias), CCN No. 20714, (collectively. Applicants), filed an application for sale, transfer or merger (STM) of facilities and certificate rights in in Cameron County. The application was filed under the provisions in the Tex. Water Code Ann. § 13.301 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin Code §§ 24.109 and 24.112 (TAC). Specifically. Olmito seeks approval to acquire the water system assets, customers and service area of the Seller and to cancel Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20714. Olmito plans to incorporate the service area into their CCN No. 20784.

Staff has reviewed the application and supplemental information and finds the application administratively and sufficient for filing. The notice to current customers, neighboring systems and cities are attached. Staff recommends the Applicants be required to:

- 1. Provide notice to the following:
 - a) any districts, groundwater conservation districts, counties, utilities, and cities within two miles of the outer boundary of the proposed service area;
 - b) any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service area; and
 - c) any customers transferred, or other affected parties in the requested area.
- 2. Provide notice to the following neighboring entities in addition to the neighboring entities listed in the application:
 - Brownsville Navigation District
 - Cameron County
 - Cameron-Hidalgo-Willacy Regional Water Authority
 - Cameron County Drainage District 1
 - Cameron County Drainage District 3
 - Cameron County Drainage District 6
 - City of Brownsville (CCN 20217)
 - City of Los Fresnos (CCN 20792)
 - City of Rancho Viejo

- East Rio Honda WSC (CCN 20861)
- Los Fresnos MUD 1
- Military Highway WSC (CCN 20571)
- Rio Grande Palms Water District
- Rio Grande Regional Water Authority
- Southmost RWA
- Valley MUD 2 (CCN 20640)

Within 30 days of the Commission order, Staff recommends that the Applicants be required to file a copy of the actual individual notice sent with attached signed and notarized affidavit that the notice was given.

- 2. Provide a notarized Oath for Purchaser or Acquiring Entity.

The total area being requested includes approximately <u>51</u> acres and serves <u>79</u> current customers. This transaction will have the following effect on current customer's rates and services: <u>The transferred customers will pay Olmito Water Supply Corporation's rates including a monthly minimum of \$17.00 up to 2,000 gallons, plus \$1.50 for every 1,000 gallons thereafter.</u>

Affected persons may file written protests and/or request a public hearing within 30 days of this notice. To request a hearing, you must:

- (4) write a brief description of how you, the persons you represent, or the public interest would be adversely affected by the proposed transaction and transfer of the CCN: and
- (5) state your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Only those persons who submit a written request to be notified of a hearing will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled. The Commission will issue the CCN requested in the referenced application unless a hearing is scheduled to consider the transaction. If no protests or requests for hearing are filed

during the comment period, the Commission may issue the CCN 30 days after publication of this notice.
