ORDER NO. 3

DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADDRESSING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND RESTYLING

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application, regarding notice, a procedural schedule for continued processing, and restyling the petition.

On October 10, 2016, Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed administratively complete and that The Commons Water Supply, Inc. be required to provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days following the filing of actual notices.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed sufficient and administratively complete. The Commons shall provide notice consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation and as specified in the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo and Gary Horton of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the attached notice forms. The Commons shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.

Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this petition. Accordingly, the following schedule shall apply:

Event	Date
Deadline for The Commons to file signed affidavits of notice along with a copy of the notice sent to affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	November 29, 2016
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of The Commons filing proof of completed notice

Deadline to intervene	30 days after mailed or last published notice, whichever is later
