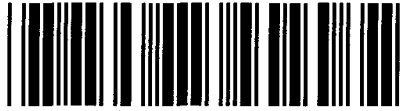

ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION COMPLETE AND SUFFICIENT;
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On July 27, 2016, Paula Weber (Weber), temporary manager of West Oaks Phoenix Corporation (West Oaks), filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application for a rate/tariff change pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.046 and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.147 (TAC).

I. Commission Staff's Comments on Administrative Completeness

On August 25, 2016, Commission Staff recommended the application and notice be deemed sufficient, but did not address the merits of the application. Commission Staff and Weber proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Weber's application and notice are deemed sufficient.

II. Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule is adopted as proposed:

Intervention deadline; deadline for intervenor comments; deadline for intervenors to request a hearing on the merits.	September 9, 2016
Deadline for Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition; deadline for Staff to request a hearing on the merits.	September 23, 2016
Deadline for applicant to respond to intervenor comments and Commission Staff recommendation on final disposition or request a hearing on the merits; deadline for parties to file a proposed notice of approval, including joint proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.	September 30, 2016
If applicable, administrative review completed – 90 days from date Commission received notice of the temporary rate increase, per 16 TAC § 24.147(c).	October 25, 2016
