MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DELAY FILING OF RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 4

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

COMES NOW, Double Diamond Utility Company, Inc. ("DDU") and files this Motion for Leave to Delay Filing of Response to Order No. 4, which is due today based upon the terms of Order No. 4.

DDU filed an Agreed Motion to Suspend Effective Date, and Abate Proceedings for 90 Days on Wednesday, November 23, 2016. As stated in the Agreed Motion, DDU intends to file an amended application with corrected rate calculations and work with the Interveners to attempt to reach a settlement. Some of the supporting documentation for DDU's application will be changed as a result of the revised calculations.
