DOCKET NO. 46262 **NOTICE OF HEARING ON EMERGENCY ORDER**

APPLICATION: Petition for an Order Appointing a Temporary Manager to Peach Creek Dam and Lake Club, Inc. in Montgomery County, Docket No. 46262.

The Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) petitioned the Commission for an emergency order appointing a temporary manager to manage the retail water utility services and operations of Peach Creek Dam and Lake Club, Inc. (Peach Creek) located in Montgomery County. Notice of Staff's petition was mailed on September 9, 2016, to the last known address of Peach Creek's headquarters and to the additional addresses listed in Staff's petition.

On September 22, 2016, the Commission granted Staff's petition and appointed John Davis as Temporary Manager of Peach Creek. A copy of the Emergency Order appointing the Temporary Manager is provided with this Notice. The appointment is effective September 23, 2016.

The Emergency Order was issued without a hearing under the authority in §§ 13.4132(b) and 13.451 of the Texas Water Code (TWC). TWC § 13.451 authorizes the Commission to issue an emergency order after providing notice and opportunity for a hearing that the Commission considers practicable under the circumstances or without notice or opportunity for a hearing. If the Commission considers the provision of notice and opportunity for a hearing practicable, the Commission shall provide notice not later than the 10th day before the date set for the hearing.

EMERGENCY ORDER HEARING: Pursuant to TWC § 13.451, the Public Utility Commission of Texas will convene a hearing on the Emergency Order at the Commission's offices at 9:30 a.m., October 7, 2016, 1701 N. Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 78701.

The Commission will consider evidence on whether to affirm, modify, or set aside the Emergency Order appointing the Temporary Manager. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 13, Texas Water Code, and Commission rules in 16 TAC Chapter 24.
