NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses Nerro Supply, LLC's August 8, 2016 application for a passthrough rate increase due to an increase in pumpage fees imposed on the utility by the San Jacinto River Authority under in its groundwater reduction plan. Riverclub River Ridge Subdivision, Public Water System No. 1700185, is the subdivision affected by the passthrough rate increase. The proposed effective date for the rate increase is September 1, 2016.

On September 13, 2016, Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed sufficient and further that the application be approved; as specified in the pleading and attached memorandum of Patricia Garcia of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended approval of a pass-through rate of \$2.94 per 1,000 gallons, effective September 1, 2016 for Nerro's customers in the Riverclub River Ridge Subdivision. Commission Staff provided revised tariff pages for Nerro.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Nerro's application is sufficient and it is approved. A new pass through rate of \$2.94 per 1,000 gallons for Nerro's customers in the Riverclub River Ridge Subdivision is approved for water service rendered as of September 1, 2016. The approved revised tariff pages are attached to this Notice.

Subject: Tariff Control No.46269, Application of Nerro Supply, LLC to Implement a Pass-Through Rate Change

On August 8, 2016, Nerro Supply, LLC (Nerro), Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12252, filed an application pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.21(h) to implement a passthrough rate increase for the pumpage fee imposed on the utility by the San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) for mandatory participation in the Groundwater Reduction Plan (GRP). Nerro listed Riverclub River Ridge Subdivision, Public Water System (PWS) No. 1700185, as the water system affected by the pass through adjustment. Nerro states that the pass-through rate increase will become effective on September 1, 2016. SJRA is increasing the Pumpage Fee and Import Fee from \$2.32/1,000 gallons to \$2.50/1,000 gallons. Nerro requested a pass-through rate of \$2.94.

Staff conducted the technical review of this application and prepared a final tariff reflecting the implementation of the change in the provision. Staff reviewed and confirmed Nerro's calculations of the pass through rate adjustment for the SJRA GRP fee as part of our analysis and recommendation. Adequate notice, including correct calculations, was provided by the Applicant to the customers. The notice contained required language pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.21(h).

Based upon review of the information submitted, Staff finds that the application is sufficient and recommends:

- 1. Approval of the pass-through change and issuance of an order to the Applicant; and
- 2. Provision of a copy of an approved tariff to the Applicant (attached).
