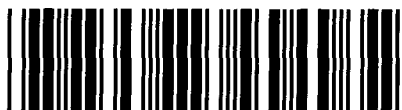


**FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,  
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of South Central Water Company's (SCWC) application. Commission Staff recommended that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's filing and attached memorandum of Emily Sears and Gary Horton, Jr. of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff further proposed that SCWC be given until October 12, 2016, to cure the deficiencies and requests that Commission Staff be given until November 10, 2016 to review the new information and file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness along with an updated proposed procedural schedule.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, SCWC's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. In accordance with 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made so, at this time, the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **October 12, 2016** SCWC shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before **November 10, 2016**, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if deemed administratively complete.
