# **COMMISSION STAFF'S AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing ' the public interest, and files this Amended Procedural Schedule, and would show the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On August 22, 2016, Dal-High Water Supply (Dal-High) and L&T Water Works filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Henderson County. Specifically, L&T Water Works seeks approval to acquire all of the water system assets of Dal-High Water Supply held under water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12830. On November 7, 2016, Staff filed its recommendation that the notice was sufficient, and proposed a procedural schedule, which was approved by Order No. 4.

### II. AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE
