



Failure by the water system to provide a minimum pressure of 35 psi throughout the distribution system under normal operating conditions.

During the investigation, the investigator observed that the pressure was 42 pounds per square inch (psi), which is above the minimum requirement of 35 psi.

**Resolution:** On October 24, 2013, the investigator documented that the pressure was above the minimum requirement.


