**ORDER NO. 2**

**DEEMING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT; ADDRESSING NOTICE AND  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation on the sufficiency of the application filed by Dal-High Water Supply and L&T Water Works (collectively, applicants) for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Henderson County.

**I. Administrative Completeness**

On September 21, 2016, Commission Staff recommended the application be found sufficient and complete. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed administratively complete.

**II. Notice**

Commission Staff also recommended that applicants provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, applicants shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's September 21, 2016 filing consistent with the criteria outlined in the memorandum of Ricky Herrera and Gary Horton, Jr. of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to the Commission Staff memorandum. Applicants shall file an affidavit evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.

**III. Procedural Schedule**

Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket. Accordingly, the following procedural schedule shall apply:

Deadline for applicants to file proof of notice with the Commission	October 24, 2016
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of applicants filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
