

has submitted an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to purchase water facilities and to cancel water CCN No. 12830 of:

Dal High Water System P.O. Box 744 Athens, TX 75751

The sale is scheduled to take place as approved by the Commission (V.T.C.A., Water Code § 13.301). The transaction and the transfer of the CCN includes the following subdivision: <u>Dal-High</u>.

The area subject to this transaction is located approximately <u>2</u> miles northwest of downtown <u>Athens</u>, <u>Texas</u>, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Caney Creek</u>; on the east by <u>One Mile Creek</u>; on the south by <u>City of Athens</u>; and on the west by <u>US 175</u>.

The total proposed area for the water CCN being requested includes approximately <u>32</u> acres and <u>46</u> current customers.

This transaction will have the following effect on the current customers' rates and services: <u>No</u> effect to customers at this time.

Affected persons may file written protests and/or request a public hearing within 30 days of this notice.

To request a hearing, you must:

- (1) state your name, mailing address and daytime telephone number;
- (2) state the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application;
- (3) the statement "I/we request a public hearing";
- (4) write a brief description of how you, the persons you represent, or the public interest would be adversely affected by the proposed transaction and transfer of the CCN; and

state your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your (5) concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Only those persons who submit a written request to be notified of a hearing will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

Persons who wish to intervene or comment should file a request in writing within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice with:

A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, Commission will not transfer the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
