SOAH ORDER NO. 6 GRANTING IN PART AGREED MOTION TO ABATE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 19, 2017, Undine Development LLC filed an Agreed Motion to Abate the Procedural Schedule (Motion) for forty-five (45) days to allow the parties an opportunity to finalize settlement negotiations in this proceeding and another proceeding. The Motion is GRANTED as to the above-styled proceeding TO THE EXTENT STATED IN THIS **ORDER** and subject to any future order by the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). As requested in the Motion, the abatement applies to all ongoing matters in this proceeding, including objections and responses to discovery requests and the filing of testimony, effective as of June 16, 2017, except as otherwise stated in this order and subject to any future order by the ALJ. At this time, the abatement does not apply to the August 18, 2017 hearing date and subsequent dates because the Motion does not state that PK-RE Development Company, Inc. agrees to an extension of the jurisdictional deadline in this case day-for-day during the period of abatement. That issue is moot if the parties timely reach a unanimous settlement of all issues; the ALJ's concern is what happens to the procedural schedule and jurisdictional deadline if they do not. The parties SHALL confer and no later than June 28, 2017, file an agreed document clarifying their intent on that point. As proposed in the Motion, the parties SHALL file a status report on or before August 1, 2017, describing the status of the settlement discussions and their proposal for bringing this matter to a resolution.
