#### **STATUS REPORT**

Undine Development LLC ("Undine") files this Status Report, pursuant to State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH") Order No.9, filed on August 28, 2017.

On August 25, 2017, Undine filed a Status Report in compliance with orders issued by the Administrative Law Judge, reporting on the settlement negotiations and requesting additional time to continue to work on a settlement. Order No. 9 granted the request and directed the parties to file a new status report by September 5, 2017.

The parties were unfortunately impacted by Hurricane Harvey and have been unable to pursue finalization of the agreement. Undine's employees experienced severe flooding, as they are located in and around Harris County, and were unable to work for several days. In order to allow sufficient time for the parties to continue to discuss and finalize the settlement agreement, and for the affected entities and associations to meet to approve same, the parties ask that they be allowed to file another status report by September 15, 2017.

All parties agree with this Status Report. PK-RE has agreed to extend the effective date of the rates for an additional ten (10) days to July 14, 2017 (see attached). By extending the proposed effective date until July 14, 2017, the 265-day suspension period ordered by SOAH will continue until April 4, 2018.

In SOAH Order No. 1, the effective date of the rates requested by PK-RE Development Company, Inc. ("PK-RE") in Phase 1 was determined to be March 19, 2017.
