COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files its Supplemental Recommendation. In support of its Supplemental Recommendation, Staff states the following:

I. Background

The City of Tomball requests water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity for a service area located in Harris and Montgomery Counties. The City of Tomball states that it currently has a water and a sewer system to serve existing residents in the proposed service area.

On November 17, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge issued Order No. 3, which deemed the City of Tomball's application administratively complete. Order No. 3 also required the City of Tomball to provide notice of its application to affected entities and to publish notice in newspapers of general circulation in Harris and Montgomery Counties. Order No. 3 established December 19, 2016 as the deadline for the City of Tomball to file affidavits regarding the provision of and publication of notice of its application.

To date, the City of Tomball has not filed any affidavits regarding the provision of and publication of notice of its application.

II. Staff's Supplemental Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City of Tomball be given additional time to file its affidavits, with the new deadline being January 13, 2017. In the event that the City of Tomball files its affidavits by January 13, 2017, Staff will review such affidavits and file a supplemental recommendation by January 27, 2017.

III. Conclusion

Staff recommends that the City of Tomball be given additional time to file affidavits regarding the provision of and publication of notice of its application.


