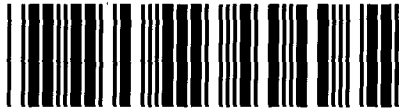

ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING
DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of City of Tomball's the application. Commission Staff recommended that the City of Tomball's application is deficient because it contains material deficiencies specifically described in Commission Staff's October 3, 2016 pleading.

Tomball's application is deemed administratively incomplete and deficient. Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **October 31, 2016**, Tomball shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **November 14, 2016** Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
