Enclosed please find the following notice for implementing the pass through rate provision for Red Oak Community/Carroll Water Company, Inc. Notice of Temporary Rules and Fee Rate Adoption and Early Payment Incentive Program Opportunity

Dear Water Well Owner or Operator:

This is to inform you of certain requirements of the Temporary District Rules ("Temporary Rules") and the water production fee rate of the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District (the "District"), as well as an opportunity pursuant to those Temporary Rules to take advantage of a substantial discount in the amount of fees owed for water produced from non-exempt wells. The current fee rate has been established at 20 cents per 1,000 gallons of water produced, and begins with water pumped on July 1, 2011 and continuing thereafter.

Under the Temporary Rules, certain existing water wells or well systems with a capacity of more than 25 gallons per minute must be registered with the District no later than June 30, 2011, and must have a meter installed on the well by July 1, 2011. The registration requirement also applies to all new wells for which drilling commences on or after April 1, 2011. Certain domestic and livestock wells and agricultural wells are exempt from the requirements under the Temporary Rules. For more information on exempt and non-exempt wells, please see Section 2 of the Temporary Rules, a copy of which is enclosed for your reference.

The Temporary Rules also require the owner or operator of a non-exempt well to pay a water use fee based on the amount of water produced from a well or well system. What this means is, an owner of a well or well system that (1) has the capacity to produce more than 25 gallons per minute <u>and</u> (2) is used for any purpose other than solely for domestic use, livestock use, poultry use, or agricultural use, <u>must</u> pay a water use fee to the District for water produced. The current fee rate has been established at 20 cents per 1,000 gallons of water produced, and begins with water pumped on July 1, 2011. Option 1 below explains the reporting and fee payment requirements and deadlines for non-exempt well owners who choose to report usage and submit fee payments to the District on a semiannual basis. However, the District has two other fee payment and reporting options that would allow well owners to take advantage of a discount in the amount of fees owed to the District. Option 2 provides a 10% fee discount for early fee payment and Option 3 provides a 5% discount for monthly fee payments. These options are further described below. All non-exempt well owners <u>must</u> submit production reports and fee payments to the District under one of the three options listed below and in accordance with the Temporary Rules.

Option 1 - Semiannual Reporting and Fee Payment at Current District Fee Rate

Under this option, beginning July 1, 2011, a registrant of a non-exempt well must read each water meter associated with the non-exempt well and record those meter readings and the actual amount of pumpage at least monthly. The production record, along with the water use fee payment, must be submitted to the District every six-month period. The first production report and fee payment is due to the District by March-1, 2012 (for water produced between July 1 and December 31, 2011). For your convenience, enclosed is a 2011 Water Production Report Form for you to fill out and submit to the District by March 1, 2012.

Option 2 - Early Fee Payment at 10% Discount

The Early Fee Payment Incentive Program allows any person required to pay a water use fee to elect to make early payments and receive a ten percent (10%) reduction in total fees due for groundwater production in a calendar year. In order to take advantage of the Early Fee Payment Incentive Program discount in 2011, a well owner or operator should estimate their water use fee payment based on their estimated groundwater production for the period of July 1 through December 31, 2011, and submit payment to the District at a 10% reduced rate no later than June 30, 2011. The registrant of a well shall read each water meter and take final meter readings for each meter associated with the well within 15 days before or after the end of the calendar year, and shall compare the difference in the estimated amount of water for which their early payment was submitted and the actual amount of water produced during the year. Depending on whether the well owner over-estimates or under-estimates the usage, the well owner/operator will either be given a credit or refund of the excess payment, or will be required to submit payment to the District for the difference between their estimate and actual production for that calendar year. Should you choose to participate in this Program, enclosed with this letter is an Early Fee Payment Incentive Program Form for you to fill out and submit to the District, along with your pre-payment, by June 30, 2011. Also enclosed is a 2011 Water Production Report Form, which you will use to record your actual water usage. This form is due to the District by March 1, 2012.

Some important deadlines for participating in this Program are as follows:

- June 30, 2011: Users who wish to participate in this Program for groundwater to be produced in the second half of calendar year 2011 must submit their estimate and reduced rate pre-payment for the second half of 2011 to the District. Non-exempt well owners must also register and meter their well by this date.
- <u>15 days before or after December 31, 2011</u>: Users are required to take final meter readings for the year and submit those to the District by *March 1, 2012*.
- March 1, 2012: Those users that underestimated their groundwater production for 2011 and participated in the Early Fee Payment Incentive Program are required to submit payment for the difference between their estimated and actual groundwater production.
 - O Users participating in this Program for calendar year 2012 must submit their water use estimate for calendar year 2012 along with their reduced rate pre-payment to the District.

Option 3 - Monthly Reporting and Fee Payment at 5% Discount

The <u>Monthly Reporting and Fee Payment Program Option</u> allows any person required to pay a water use fee to elect to submit monthly payments and reports to the District and <u>receive a five percent (5%) reduction</u> <u>in fees due</u> for groundwater produced each month.

In order to participate in this program, a well owner or operator must, not later than the tenth day of the month, read each water meter associated with a well and record the meter reading and the actual amount of pumpage since the previous month's meter reading. The well owner or operator must then calculate the total amount of fees owed to the District for groundwater produced since the previous month's meter reading, and must submit a monthly production record and fee payment to the District at a discounted rate of 5% off the total amount of water use fees calculated for that month. The monthly production record and fee payment must be received by the District no later than the last day of the month following the month for which groundwater production is being reported.

A well owner with an existing well who participates in the monthly reporting and payment option program for the July 1 through December 31, 2011, semiannual reporting period must take an initial meter reading on or before **July 1, 2011**, and an ending meter reading between August 1 and August 10, 2011 for purposes of calculating July 2011 monthly water production. The production report and fee payment for July 2011 monthly water production must be received by the District no later than August 31, 2011.

owner will become ineligible to participate in the Monthly Reporting and Fee Payment Program for the remainder of the current semiannual reporting period and will remain ineligible until the beginning of the next semiannual reporting period. The well owner may continue to pay monthly at the full Water Use Fee rate for the remainder of the semiannual reporting period, so long as all fees and reports are submitted by the deadlines applicable to the regular reporting for the semiannual reporting period. If you choose to participate in this Program, please use the enclosed 2011 Water Production Report Form when submitting monthly production records and fee payments to the District.

Some important deadlines for participating in this Program during the July 1 through December 31, 2011, semiannual reporting period are as follows:

- June 30, 2011: Users who wish to participate in the <u>Monthly Reporting and Fee Payment Program</u> must have registered their well with the District and installed a meter on their well or well system by this date.
- On or before July 1, 2011: Users must take an initial meter reading.
- <u>Between August 1 and August 10, 2011:</u> Users must take an ending meter reading for purposes of calculating July 2011 monthly water production.
- <u>August 31, 2011</u>: Participants in this Program must submit the July 2011 monthly production report and fee payment so that it is received by the District no later than this date.

The District is committed to working with the public to ensure that the public is informed and aware of the ongoing activities of the District. The District appreciates your help in identifying non-exempt or non-compliant wells within the District.
