**ORDER NO. 1
 PROVIDING NOTICE AND REQUIRING JOINT PROPOSED ORDER**

On September 19, 2016, Aqua Texas, Inc. (Aqua) filed a notice of intent, pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 13.254 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.113, to provide service to area decertified from Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority's (GCWDA's) sewer certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 20465 in Chambers County. Aqua intends to provide retail sewer utility service to the 94,247-acre tract of land released from GCWDA by decertification in Docket No. 45337.¹ Aqua included an affidavit from GCWDA, noting a determination that no property was rendered useless or valueless, no compensation is owed, and no appraisal is needed to determine just compensation owed to GCWDA for the release.

A notice is included with this Order which will appear in the October 7, 2016, issue of the *Texas Register*.

So that this proceeding may continue to final resolution, Aqua and GCWDA shall file, on or before **October 11, 2016**, (1) a list of items for admission into evidence, and (2) a joint proposed order, including findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.
