#### COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

Comes now the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files its Recommendation on Sufficiency of Notice in response to Order No. 4. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

#### I. Background

On September 19, 2016, Sherman's Mill Water Supply Corporation ("Sherman's Mill" or "Applicant") filed an application to obtain a new water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Kerr County. The proposed total area being requested includes approximately 53.65 acres and 15 current customers. On December 1, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge (the "ALJ") issued Order No. 4, requiring Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice within 10 days of Sherman's Mill filing proof of completed notice with the Commission. Sherman's Mill filed its affidavit of notice on January 9, 2017. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

#### II. Staff's Recommendation

Staff has reviewed Sherman Mill's proof of notice and, and as detailed by the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo of the Water Utilities Division, Staff recommends that notice be deemed insufficient and, therefore, incomplete. In particular, Sherman's Mill failed to provide notice to Gillespie County WCID 1. Staff recommends that Sherman's Mill be required to provide notice to Gillespie County WCID 1, and once it has done so, file the completed attached affidavit that notice was given, a copy of the actual notice sent, and the map that was sent with the individual notice. In addition, the property description on Exhibit A to Sherman's Mill's affidavit does not match the property description provided by the Commission (and purportedly listed in the actual notice sent to neighboring systems, cities, and landowners). Staff recommends that

Sherman's Mill explain why the description in Exhibit A differs from the description contained in the actual notice sent.

Further, Staff has identified multiple issues that will need to be addressed during the financial review process. Therefore, Staff recommends that Applicant provide the following information.

- Monthly bank statements for calendar year 2015.
- A written response detailing the Applicant's outstanding debt or debt service obligations.
   The Applicant should provide copies of all debt agreement(s) including terms and related amortization schedule if applicable.
- A written response detailing the Applicant's plan to increase expenses over the next five years, including how the Applicant plans to address the increase, and projected income and expenses, if applicable.

#### III. Conclusion

For the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully recommends that an order be issued finding Sherman's Mill's notice insufficient and ordering Sherman's Mill to cure the deficiency by February 15, 2017, and that Staff be given 10 days from Sherman's Mill filing proof of completed notice to file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of notice.

On September 19, 2016, Sherman's Mill WSC (Applicant) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application requesting to obtain a water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Kerr County, Texas. The application is being reviewed under Texas Water Code §13.254(d) (TWC) and Title 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§24.115 and 24.102(a)(1) (TAC). The proposed total area being requested includes approximately 48 acres and 15 current customers.

Staff reviewed the notice documents filed by the Applicant on January 9, 2017, and found the following deficiencies:

- The Applicant failed to provide notice to Gillespie County WCID 1. The Applicant will need to file a copy of the actual notice sent, the map that was sent with the individual notice, and the attached signed affidavit that the notice was given. It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notice and affidavits to meet these requirements.
- Exhibit A contains a notice description that conflicts with the description of the proposed area in the notices provided to the Applicant by the Commission. The Applicant should clarify the purpose of the notice description contained in Exhibit A.

#### **Financial Review**

The following items must be submitted by the Applicant in order for Staff to complete the financial review of the application. Staff recommends the Applicant provide the items listed below within 21 days from the date of the Commission's order.

- 1) Monthly bank statements for calendar year 2015.
- 2) A written response detailing the Applicant's outstanding debt or debt service obligations. The Applicant should provide copies of all debt agreement(s) including terms and related amortization schedule if applicable.

3) A written response detailing the Applicant's plan to increase expenses over the next five years, including how the Applicant plans to address the increase, and projected income and expenses, if applicable.

All voluminous data should be provided electronically, especially the general ledgers and financial statements which should be provided in excel format.

The Sherman's Mill WSC has submitted an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to obtain a CCN to provide water service in Kerr County.

The proposed utility area is located within approximately <u>4</u> miles <u>West</u> from downtown <u>Ingram</u>, <u>Texas</u>, and is generally <u>Bounded on the north by the Guadalupe River</u>; on the east by <u>Kelly Creek Road</u>; Bounded on the south by <u>Kelly Creek Rd & Huntleigh Rd</u>; and on the west by <u>2</u> miles west of Kelly Creek Rd

The proposed total area being requested includes approximately 48 acres and serves 15 current customers.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Persons who wish to intervene or comment should write the:

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed service area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed service area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All requests to opt out of the requested service area must include a large scale map and a metes and bounds description of the tract of land:
