**FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's October 19, 2016 recommendation that the application of Sherman's Mill Water Supply Corporation for a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Kerr County is deficient. Commission Staff identified mapping deficiencies and technical issues with the application, which are specified in Commission Staff's pleading and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo, Kristi Nguyen, Fred Bednarski III and Ricky Herrera in the Commission's water utility regulation division. Commission Staff recommended that Sherman's Mill be given until November 10, 2016 to cure the identified deficiencies in its application, and that Staff be given until November 30, 2016 to file a supplemental recommendation and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Sherman's Mill's application is deemed administratively incomplete and deficient. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made;¹ thus, at this time Sherman's Mill's application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **November 10, 2016**, Sherman's Mill shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **November 30, 2016** Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
