- 1. The meeting was called to order by President Dennis Goldsberry at 2:00 p.m.
- 2. Camarillo moved to approve the minutes for July 14, 2006. Cuevas seconded and the motion carried.
- Garda moved to approve the July 2006 financial statement as presented. Krenek seconded and the motion carried.
- Steven Sanchez reported the month of July water loss was at 15.41%. The year to date is 17.09%.
- 5. Jesse Aguirre reported on the wastewater department for the month of July 2008. (See attached)
- Camarillo moved to approve payments of \$67,837.75 to Rio Valley Construction, \$531,630.96 to System Controls & Instrumentation, \$18,090,00 to Peacock General Contractors, \$77,177.91 to Rhyner Construction Co., for the North Cameron Project; \$15,930.00 to Peacock General Contractors for the Doolittle Road RO Project; and \$106,740.00 to Peacock General Contractors for the Owassa Road RO Project.
