**DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

I. Administrative Completeness

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application. Commission Staff finds that the application is sufficient for further review and recommends that the application and notice be deemed administratively complete. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, MSEC's application is deemed administratively complete.

II. Notice

Commission Staff has reviewed MSEC's proposed notice with regard to applicable statutes and rules, and recommends MSEC send the notice as described in Commission Staff's October 28, 2016 filing and the attached memorandum of Greg Charles and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to the Commission Staff memorandum.

Consistent with Staff's recommendation, MSEC shall provide notice as described in Staff's recommendation and file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.


III. Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule as proposed by Commission Staff is adopted:

Event	Date
Deadline for applicant to provide the Commission with the Affidavits of Notice, along with the individual notice issued including the accompanying map, and the published notice	December 13, 2016
Deadline for Commission Staff to file comments on proof of notice	14 days after applicant files proof of notice
Deadline for intervention; deadline for affected intervenors to request a hearing on the merits	30 days after notice is issued
