**COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest and files this Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule and would show the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On October 3, 2016, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. filed with the Commission an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12887 in Montgomery County. Order No. 3, filed on December 20, 2016, set the procedural schedule in this proceeding. On March 13, 2017, MSEC filed a notice of substitution of counsel, indicating new representation.

**II. MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On November 17, 2016, Staff filed its first request for information (RFI) on MSEC. Based on informal discussions with MSEC's previous counsel, Staff agreed to allow MSEC additional time to answer the RFI. To date, no response has been received. Staff has discussed this discovery issue with MSEC's substituted counsel, who advised that MSEC will file its RFI response shortly. Additional time is required to allow Staff to receive and review the discovery. Therefore, Staff proposes the following amended procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to MSEC for review and consent	May 1, 2017
Deadline for MSEC to file signed consent forms with the Commission.	May 15, 2017

If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	May 22, 2017
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	May 29, 2017




