**ORDER NO. 2
DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

I. Administrative Completeness

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application. Commission Staff finds that the application is sufficient for further review and recommends that the application and notice be deemed administratively complete. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, MSEC's application is deemed administratively complete.

II. Notice

Commission Staff has reviewed MSEC's proposed notice with regard to applicable statutes and rules, and recommends MSEC send notice as described in Commission Staff's November 1, 2016 filing and attached memorandum of Ricky Herrera and Gary Horton, Jr. of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

MSEC shall correct the docket number on the proposed Notice for Publication from 43423 to 46423 and then provide notice as described in Staff's recommendation and file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.

III. Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule as proposed by Commission Staff is adopted:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of MSEC filing proof of completed notice
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
