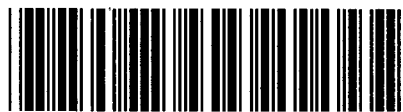

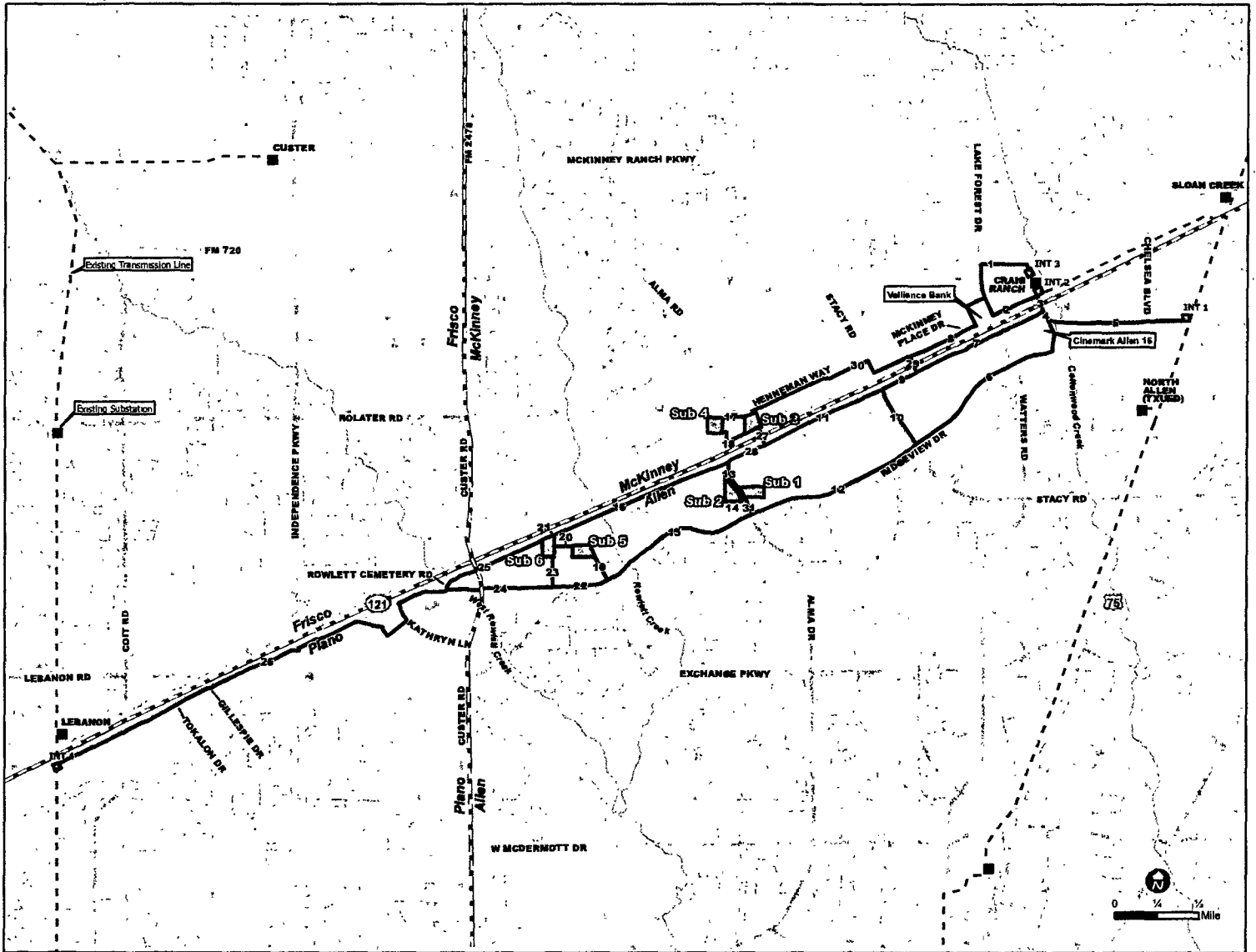

To whom it may concern,


I feel very strongly that the substation and transmission lines for the Kittyhawk project be built on the **NORTH** side of Hwy 121 (Docket Number 46429). There are already proposed options mapped out before you, Substation 3 and Substation 4. My rationale for this request is as follows:

-there will soon be a new Allen Independent School District STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics) Center built on Ridgeview Road near Exchange Parkway, which includes an outdoor learning pavilion. I am extremely concerned about potential known and unknown health hazards for our children should the substation and subsequent transmission lines be built on the south side of 121 in this area.

- property values to the NUMEROUS PREEXISTING HOMES would dramatically decrease due to the negative aesthetics of this project's substation and transmission lines adjacent to their properties.

-it is very commercial on the north side of 121. The project aesthetics would impact very few, if any, homeowners. A house is probably the largest purchase any citizen makes, so your decision should recognize this and protect the taxpaying citizens that have already built and invested in their homes. You do have 2 options that would protect these homeowners.
