
I am requesting to intervene in this proceeding. As an INTERVENOR, I understand the following:

Proposed Routes crossing our P. Bush Elkin Property Co.'s property in Allen, TX:
 Segment 12 at N.W. corner of Stacy Rd. (at Seg. 6) intersection & Ridgeview Dr., extending west on north side of Ridgeview Dr. over bridge, ending at intersection of Creekway Dr., not quite to Alma Dr, directly across from City of Allen's Public Park/recreational uses/bike & running paths/quality residential areas/agricultural properties. Proposed transmission lines here are definitely contrary to existing uses, hazardous health risks & negative impact visually on existing & future land uses. They should not be above ground, but buried underground.
- Segment 11 at intersection on South side of S.H. 121 at CR 149, negatively crosses north on our property going east toward Stacy Rd. All transmission lines should be on North side of S.H. 121 on McKinney side being the shortest, least expensive route & most appropriate existing land uses.
