Comes now the Staff ("Staff") of the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission"), representing the public interest, and files this Response to Order No. 3, which set March 17, 2017, as a deadline to provide a status update, if appropriate. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

On March 10, 2017, Management & Training Corporation ("MTC") provided an update notifying the Commission that MTC and the City of Overton have reached a settlement. MTC requested until April 10, 2017, to file a motion to dismiss or an alternative motion based on whether the Overton City Council approves the settlement at an upcoming council meeting. Staff does not oppose the request for an extension.
