ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION AND NOTICE DEFICIENT AND INCOMPLETE; SUSPENDING PROPOSED EFFECTIVE DATE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's December 20, 2016 recommendation that the application of J&S Water Company, LLC for a rate/tariff change is deficient, as specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Janie Kohl, Jonathan Ramirez, Andrew Novak and Ricardo Herrera, of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that J&S Water's proposed rates be suspended until the deficiencies are cured. In addition, J&S Water must re-notice its customers with a new effective date at least 35-days before the new effective date of the proposed change. If desired, J&S Water may send a copy of its revised notice to Commission Staff for confirmation prior to issuance.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, J&S Water's application and notice are found administratively incomplete and deficient. Further, the effective date for J&S Water's proposed rate change is suspended indefinitely. On or before **January 6, 2017**, J&S Water shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff.

On or before **January 20, 2017**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
