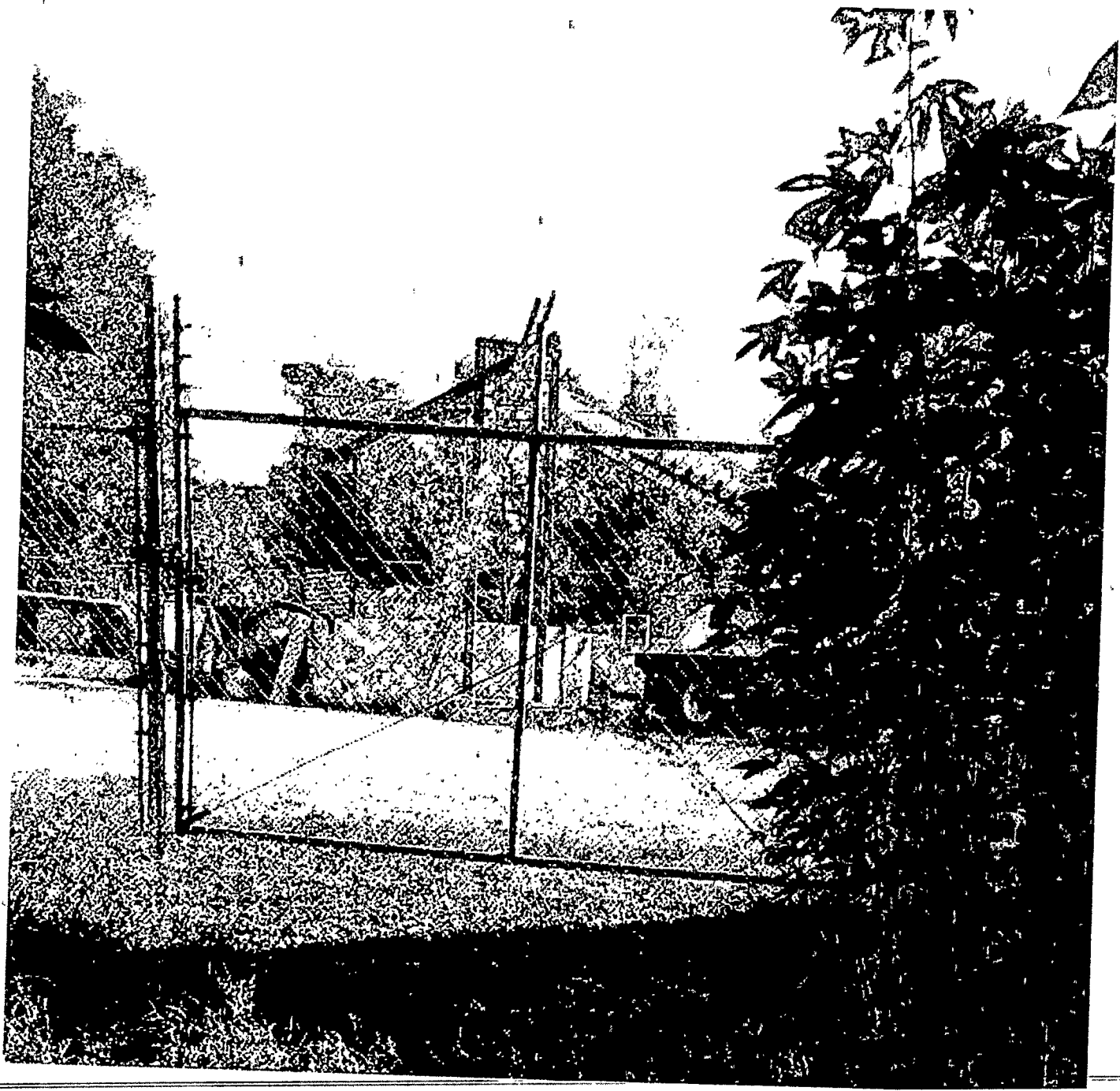

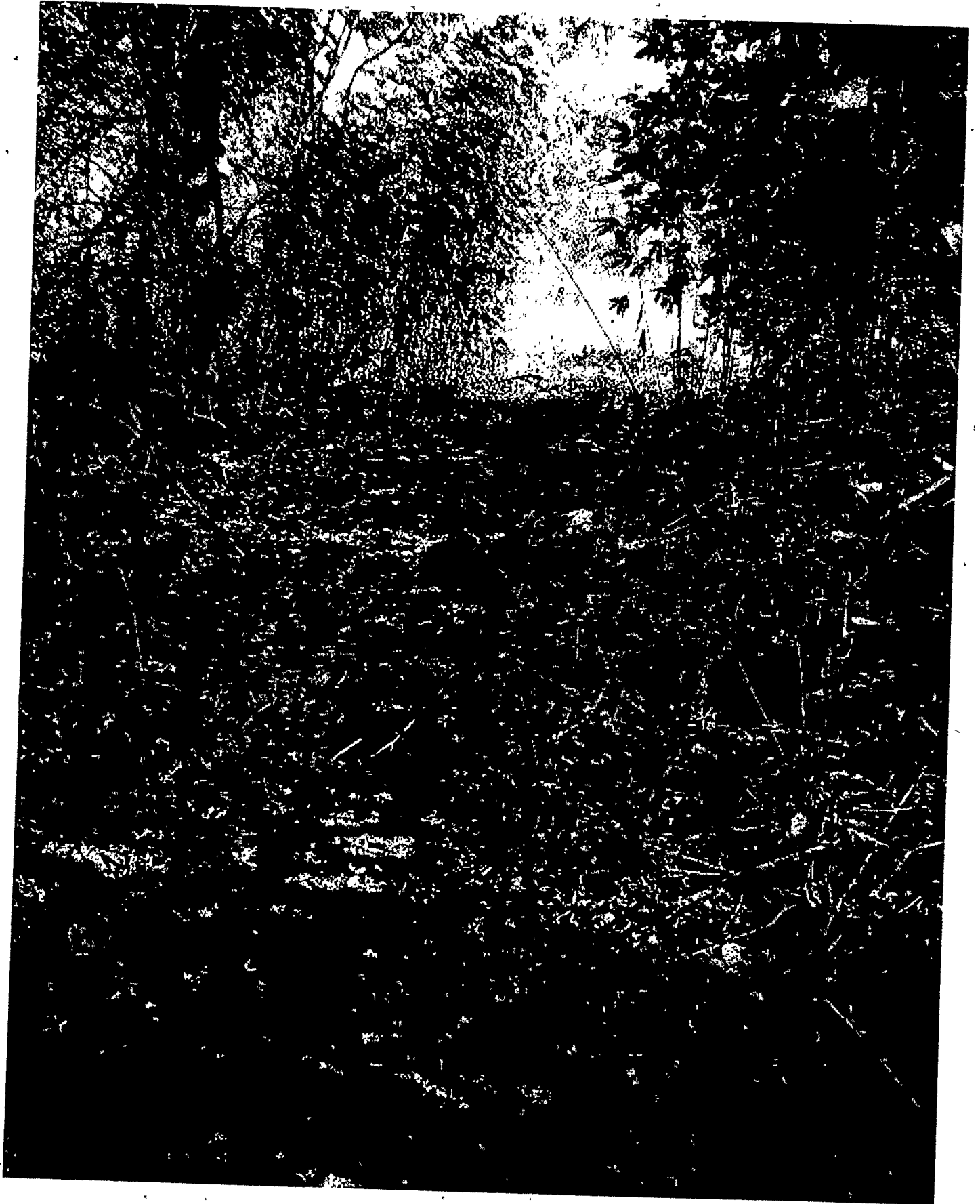

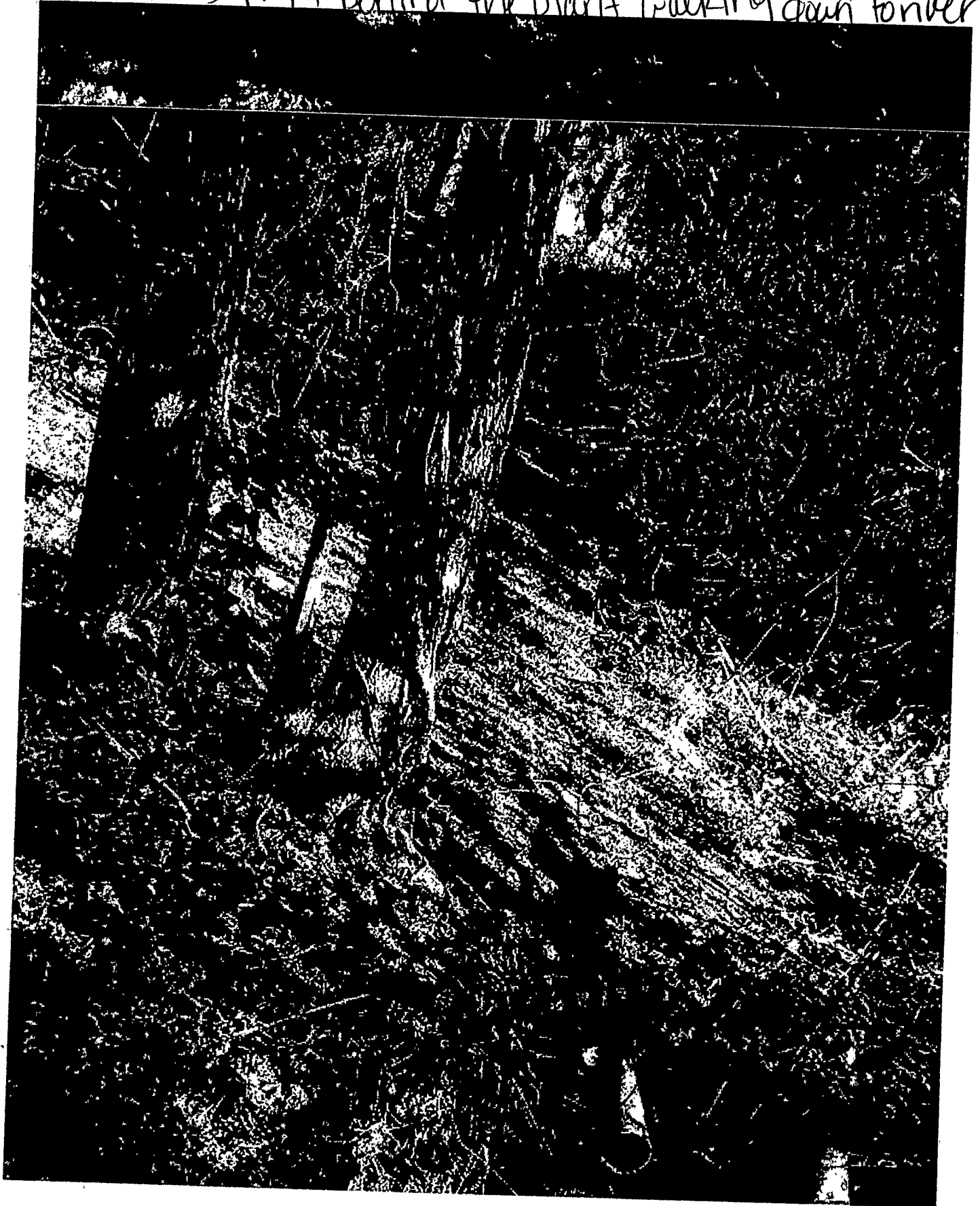
Mrs. Ruff,

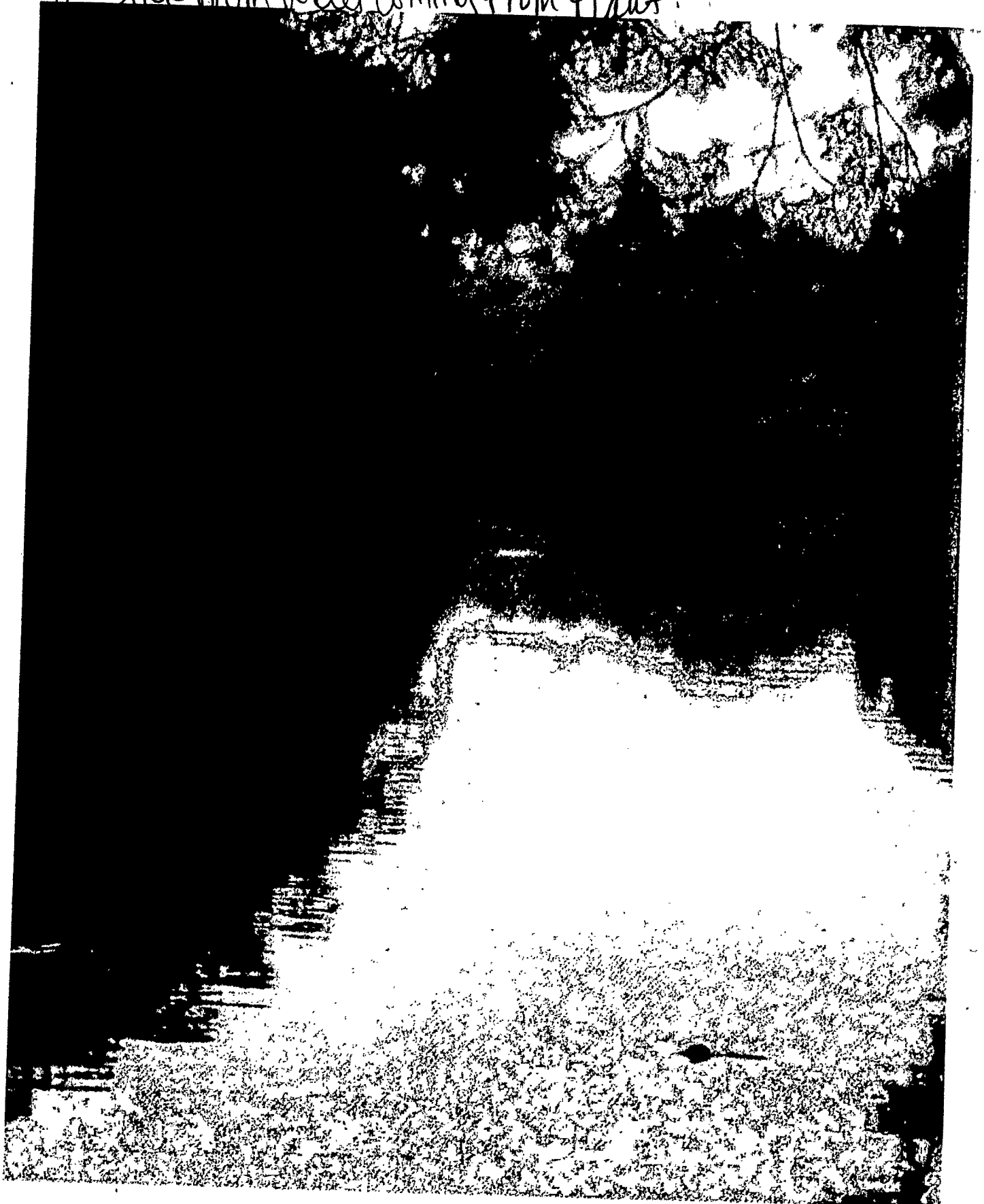
this was from behind the plant walking down to river



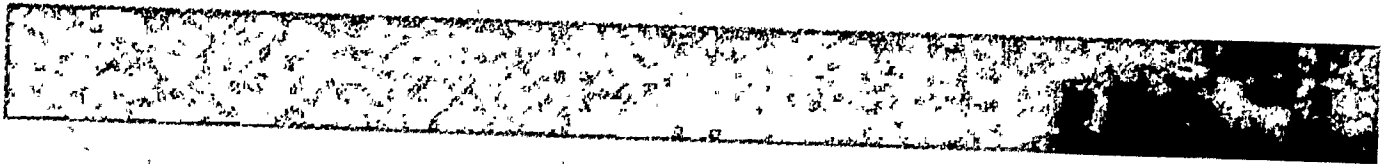




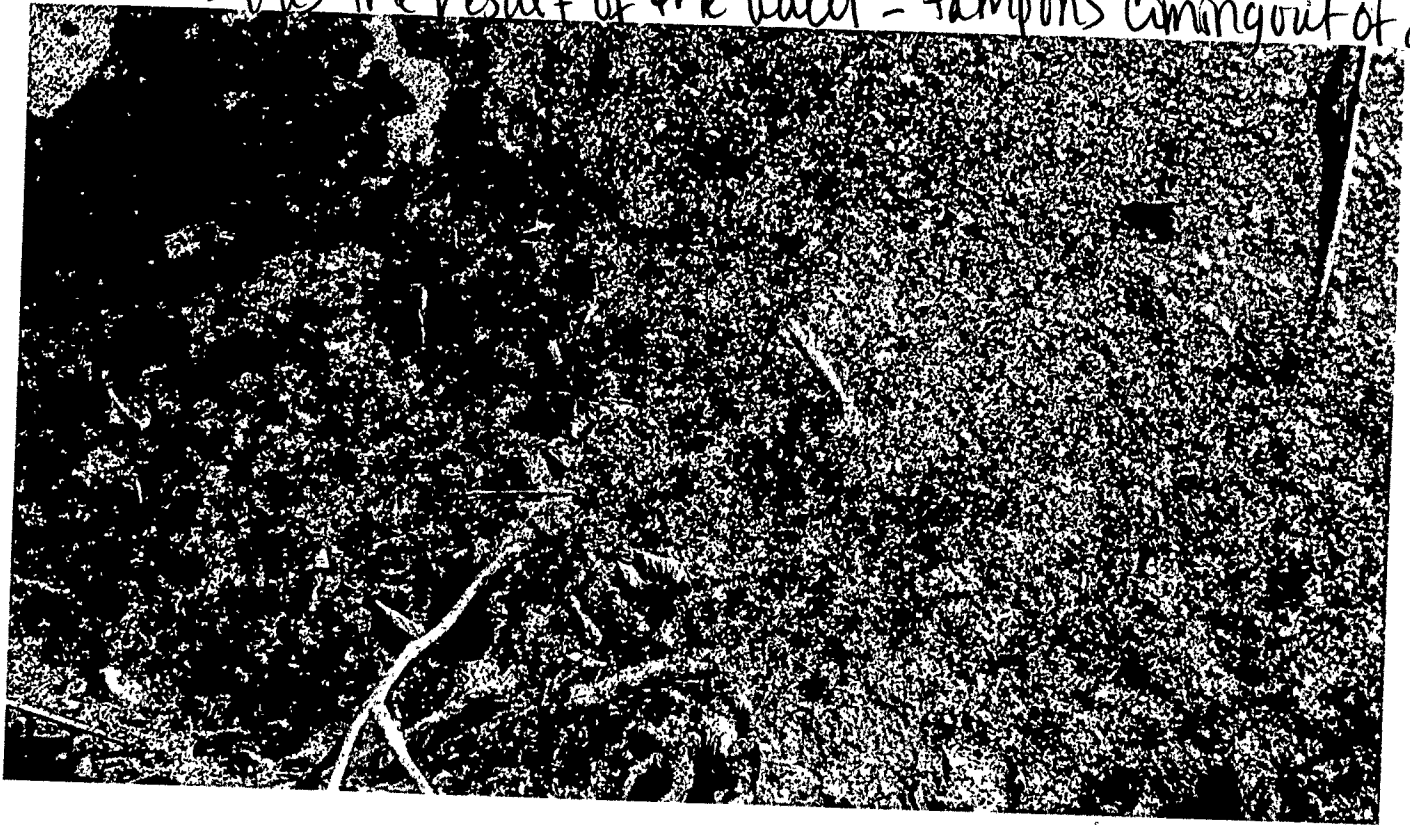
oil slick from water coming from plant.
