#### STAFF'S COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND PROPOSED NOTICE

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this response to Order No. 1 and would show the following:

#### I. Background

On October 14, 2016, the Terra Southwest, Inc. (Terra) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 11608 in Denton County, Texas. On October 19, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 1 requiring Staff to file comments on the application's administrative completeness and proposed notice by November 14, 2016. Therefore, this response is timely.

#### II. Administrative Completeness

Staff has reviewed Terra's application and, as supported by the attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez and Kristi Nguyen of the Water Utilities Division, recommends that it is administratively complete in accordance with Tex. Water Code Ann. § 13.246 (West 2016) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.106 (TAC).

#### III. Notice

The Commission's notice requirements for CCN applications are specified in 16 TAC § 24.106. Staff has reviewed Terra's proposed notice and recommends that it meets the requirements of the rule. Additionally, Staff recommends Terra file its notice in accordance with the recommendations contained in the attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez and Kristi Nguyen.

## IV. Procedural Schedule

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

## V. Conclusion

Staff recommends that Terra's application be deemed administratively complete. Additionally, Staff recommends that Staff's proposed procedural schedule be adopted.

On October 14, 2016, Terra Southwest (Applicant), filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11608 in Denton County, Texas. The application is being reviewed under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§13.242-.250 and 16 Tex. Admin Code (TAC) §§ 24.101-.107.

A Staff review of the information filed by the Applicant found that it is sufficient in the required application and mapping information. Therefore, Staff recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for filing and found administratively complete. Staff further recommends the following:

- 1) The Applicant provide notice of the application to the following:
  - a) any districts, utilities, and cities within two (2) miles of the proposed area;
  - b) the county judge of each county and each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified;
  - c) each city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area to be certified;
  - d) landowners who own a tract of land that is at least 25 acres and is wholly or partly located in the proposed area to be certified. The landowner information may be obtained from the county appraisal district tax rolls for the county or counties in which the proposed CCN is located; and
  - e) publish notice once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Denton County.
- 2) The Applicant should provide correct 2 mile notice list of neighboring entities as follows:
  - Town of Little Elm (11202)
  - City of Oak Point
  - City of Lakewood Village (10201)
  - Aqua Texas, Inc. (13201)
  - Knob Hill Water System (11414)
  - Mustang SUD (11856)
  - City of Hackberry (12015)

  - Denton County FWSD 8A (13018)

- Valencia on the Lake WCID (13138)

- 3) The Applicant be ordered to include copy of a map showing the proposed service area with the individual notices to neighboring utilities, other affected parties and each landowner. It is the Applicant's burden to provide an accurate map delineating the proposed area with each individual notice. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained from the TCEQ's web site located at <a href="http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/">http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/</a>.
- 4) The Applicant file within 30 days of the Commission order, a copy of the actual notice and map issued, along with signed affidavits indicating that the notice was given. It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notices and affidavits to meet these requirements.
