# TEXAS INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS' SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY'S 'SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

- 2-1 For each witness presenting testimony for TIEC, to the extent not provided with his or her pre-filed testimony or workpapers already submitted in this proceeding, please provide:
  - a. any testimony they have previously presented addressing relating to ratemaking treatment of a retired power plant;
  - b. any testimony they have previously presented addressing relating to the prudence of retiring a power plant; and
  - c. any testimony they have previously presented addressing, or relating to the installation of environmental controls at a power plant

#### **RESPONSE:**

a-c. SWEPCO has agreed to limit this RFI to responsive testimonies submitted within the past seven years. Pursuant to an agreement with SWEPCO, TIEC provides this original response with respect to testimonies submitted within the past five years, and will file a supplemental response addressing any additional responsive testimonies within the past seven years.

Mr. Pollock is not aware of any testimony he submitted in the last five years on the ratemaking treatment of retiring a power plant or relating to the installation of environmental controls at a power plant. Mr. Pollock did submit testimony on the prudence and reasonableness of a utility's decision to buy-out a purchased power agreement by acquiring and then subsequently retiring the corresponding asset in Docket No. 150075 before the Florida Public Service Commission.
