ORDER NO. 2 DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. Administrative Completeness

This Order addresses Commission Staff's November 18, 2016 recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application. Commission Staff finds that the application is sufficient for further review and recommends that the application and notice be deemed administratively complete. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Royse City's application is deemed administratively complete.

II. Commission Staff Recommendation on Notice

Commission Staff recommended that the parties provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date. Consistent with Staff's recommendation, applicants shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's November 18, 2016 pleading, consistent with the criteria outlined in the attached memorandum of Ricky Herrera and Gary Horton, Jr. of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the form attached to the Commission Staff memorandum. Applicants shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.



III. Restyling Docket

Commission Staff recommended the docket be restyled to reflect that Royse City is seeking to cancel Verandah's water and sewer CCNs rather than decertifying a portion of Verandah's service area. The style of this docket shall be amended to read: Application of the City of Royse City to Amend its Water and Sewer Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) and Cancel Verandah Municipal Utility District's CCNs in Hunt and Rockwall Counties.

IV. Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule as proposed by Commission Staff is adopted:
