ORDER *NUNC PRO TUNC* CORRECTING PARTY NAMES IN
SECTION V. OF SOAH ORDER NO. 1

On January 17, 2017, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued SOAH Order No. 1 in this case. The order contained an error in Section V. regarding party status. Section V. should read as follows:

V. PARTY STATUS

As of the date this order is issued, the only parties to this contested case are Altoga Water Supply Corporation and North Collin Special Utility District, as Applicants, and the Staff of the Commission. Under the Commission's procedural rules, the persons who have filed written comments, letters of protest and requests for hearing with the Commission are not parties to this case. To become a party to this case and have the right to present a case, cross-examine witnesses, participate in discovery, and make oral or written legal arguments to the ALJ, a person or entity must file a motion to intervene pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.104. All persons who have filed written comments, letters of protests, and requests for hearing are welcome to attend the telephonic prehearing conference.
