

THIS AGREEMENT by Altoga Water Supply Corporation ("Altoga" or "the Corporation") and North Collin Special Utility District (the "District") is based on the following recitals:

WHEREAS, Altoga is a Texas nonprofit corporation incorporated pursuant to Article 1434a of the Revised Texas Civil Statutes, now Chapter 67 of the Texas Water Code;

WHEREAS, Altoga operates a public water system for its members in Collin County, Texas, that provides potable water from two water wells to approximately 400+ members (the "System");

WHEREAS, Altoga operates the System pursuant to a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") No.12580 issued by a predecessor agency of the Public Utilities Commission of Texas ("PUC");

WHEREAS, the Altoga Board of Directors find that the Corporation does not have sufficient resources to improve the System so that it will provide continuous and adequate service to its members in accordance with the complex regulations that govern the System;

WHEREAS, the board of directors of Altoga find that it is in the best long term interests of the members of the System to transfer all of Altoga's assets and CCN to the District which has the financial; managerial and technical ability to provide continuous and adequate water service to its customers, including the members of Altoga;

WHEREAS, the District is a conservation and reclamation district created under the authority of Article XVI, Section 59, Texas Constitution and governed by Chapters 65 and 49 of the Texas Water Code;

WHEREAS, effective June 10, 2016, the District assumed the responsibility to operate and maintain the System, pursuant to an Operation and Maintenance Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the District's Board of Directors find that it is in the best interests of the District and its customers to acquire the assets of Altoga and assume the operating responsibility of the System.

1. TRANSFER OF ASSETS

- 1.1 On the Effective Date, Altoga will transfer all of its interest in real property to the District by it's president executing the following documents:
 - a. A special warranty deed attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> which, following execution, will be filed in the real property records of Collin County, Texas; and
 - b. An assignment of easements attached hereto as <u>Exhibit B</u> which, following execution, will be filed in the real property records of Collin County, Texas.

- 1.3 On the Effective Date, Altoga will transfer all its intangible personal property in the form of cash or cash equivalents held, owned or controlled by Altoga to the District, including but not limited to all accounts in any financial institutions, accounts receivables owed by members or third parties by executing the Assignment of Accounts attached hereto as Exhibit D and delivering the same to the District.
- 1.4 On the Effective Date, the District, as the owner of the System, will assume direct responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the System for the benefit of it's customers, and the Operation and Maintenance Agreement between Altoga and the District will terminate.
- 1.5 All asset transfers will be subject to perfected security interest of the Texas Water Development Board and the United States of America, acting through the Rural Utilities Service of the United States Department of Agriculture
- 1.6 The District will take any and all steps necessary to assume Altoga's promissory notes payable to the Texas Water Development Board and the United States of America, acting through the Rural Utilities Service of the United States Department of Agriculture.
- 1.7 When fully prepared, Altoga will execute with the District the PUC Sale Merger Transfer form and fully cooperate with the District to obtain the PUC's approval for the transfer of CCN No. 12580 to the District.

- 2.2 Altoga has full negotiable title to all of the assets described in this Agreement and it's Attached exhibits, all of which are free and clear of any lien or encumbrance;
- 2.3 Altoga is not a party to and has not been notified or threatened with any litigation, complaint, enforcement proceedings, administrative proceeding of any kind;
- 2.4 Altoga's board of directors have approved this Agreement at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors by the vote required by Altoga's Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws; and
- 2.5 Altoga's membership has approved this Agreement and authorized its execution by Altoga's president by an appropriate resolution approved by a least two-thirds of Altoga's membership present in person or by proxy at an annual or special called meeting of Altoga's membership.

In order to induce Altoga to execute this Agreement, the District makes the following representations:

- 3.1 The District is authorized to execute this Agreement pursuant to a resolution adopted by its Board of Directors and pursuant to §49.211 of the Texas Water Code;
- 3.2 The District agrees that all membership fees paid by Altoga's current members, to the extent that the membership fees can be identified and confirmed in Altoga's books and records, will be accounted for and maintained by the District in the same manner as the District maintains accounts for customer deposits;
- 3.3 The District agrees to increase the number of directors on its board from six (6) to seven (7) directors. After the Effective Date of the transfer of the Altoga's assets and liabilities to the District, the District will appoint a qualified individual that resides in the Altoga service area to the District's board of directors. 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appointee will have the opportunity to run for re-election at the appropriate time; and

3.4 The District will take all reasonable and necessary actions to complete the transfer of Altoga's assets to the District, assume the responsibility of operating the System, preparation and filing PUC Sale Merger Transfer form and all other actions required by the PUC to obtain PUC's approval of the transfer of Altoga's assets and CCN to the District.

4. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 4.1 This Agreement shall be governed by and construed and enforced under the laws of the State of Texas.
- 4.2 The obligations and undertakings of each of the parties to this Agreement shall be performed in Collin County, Texas. Except for matters within the jurisdiction of the TCEQ or its successor, the parties expressly agree that all judicial proceedings to enforce any of the provisions of this Agreement shall take place in Collin County or Travis County, Texas, as appropriate.
- 4.3 This Agreement contains the entire agreement of Altoga and the District with respect to the subject matter of the agreement. No agreement, statement, or promise made by any party or to any employee, agent, or officer of any party, that is not contained in this Agreement shall be valid, binding, or of any force or effect. 

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ORDINANCE NO. 2016-001

AN ORDINANCE OF NORTH COLLIN SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT"), COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, RELATING TO THE RATES CHARGED BY THE DISTRICT TO ITS CUSTOMERS FOR WATER SERVICE AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 1. WATER SERVICE RATES

The Board of Directors approve of and adopt the water service rates stated on Exhibit A attached hereto.

SECTION 2. CONFLICTS

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All ordinances and provisions of ordinances of the District that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, and all ordinances and provisions of ordinances of the District not so repealed are hereby retained in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

It is the intent of the District that each paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be deemed severable and, should any such paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section be declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such declaration of invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed to affect the validity of those provisions of this ordinance left standing.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

The rates contained in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, are effective as of October 1, 2016.

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Notes to Financial Statements December 31, 2011

(1) SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies of the North Collin Water Supply Corporation (Corporation) conform to accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. The following is a summary of the significant policies.

A. Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Corporation were prepared using the accrual basis of accounting. Material amounts of goods and services are recorded as assets or expenses at the time the liabilities arise, which is normally when title to the goods pass or when the services are received. Encumbrances representing outstanding purchase orders and other commitments for materials or services not yet received are not liabilities as of the reporting date.

B. Basis of Presentation

In order to comply with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, the Corporation must prepare its external financial statements in accordance with statements issued by the Financial Accounting Standards Board. The Board requires that all not-for-profit organizations provide a statement of financial position, a statement of activities, and a statement of cash flows. It requires reporting amounts for the Corporation's total assets, liabilities, and net assets in a statement of financial position; reporting the change in the Corporation's net assets in a statement of activities; and reporting the change in its cash and cash equivalents in a statement of cash flows.

C. Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from these estimates.

D. Income Tax Status

The Corporation is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(12) of the Internal Revenue Service.

(2) CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS

For the purposes of the statement of cash flows, cash equivalents include time deposits, certificates of deposit, and highly liquid debt instruments with original maturities of three months or less from date of purchase.

(2) CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS (continued)

At December 31, 2011, the Corporation's carrying amount of deposits was \$400,370 and the bank balance of the Corporation's deposits was \$423,754. Of the bank balance \$423,754 was covered by federal depository insurance.

It is the Corporation's policy to capitalize expenditures of \$500 or more for assets with a useful life exceeding one year or that extend the life of another asset.

(5) LONG-TERM DEBT

On November 21, 2006 the Corporation entered into a loan agreement with the United States Department of Agriculture for \$1,420,000. The purpose of the loan was to fund construction of the Chambersville overhead storage tank and associated water lines. The loan requires monthly payments of \$6,447 beginning on January 21, 2008 for a period of forty years. Payments include an interest rate of 4.5%.

On October 21, 2010 the Corporation entered into an agreement with Independent Bank for a line of credit in the amount of \$400,000. Annualized interest of 2.90% is charged on the outstanding balance at the end of each month. The line of credit is secured by cetificates of deposit. There was no balance outstanding as of December 31, 2011.

On December 15, 2011 the Corporation entered in a loan agreement with Ford Credit in the amount of \$28,383. The purpose of the loan was to finance the purchase of a 2011 Ford Super Duty F-250 truck. The loan requires monthly payments of \$540 beginning January 29, 2012 for a period of five years. Payments include an interest rate of 5.24%.

(1) <u>NATURE OF ACTIVITIES</u>

North Collin Water Supply Corporation origniated in 1970 with a mission to deliver water to rural customers. Treated water is purchased from Lake Lavon through the North Texa's Municipal Water District in Wylie, Texas for delivery to customers in rural northern Collin County.

(6) LONG-TERM DEBT

On November 21, 2006 the Corporation entered into a loan agreement with the United States Department of Agriculture for \$1,420,000. The purpose of the loan was to fund construction of the Chambersville overhead storage tank and associated water lines. The loan requires monthly payments, of \$6,447 beginning on January 21, 2008 for a period of forty years. Payments include an interest rate of 4.5%.

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(6) <u>LONG-TERM DEBT</u> (continued)

On October 21, 2010 the Corporation entered into an agreement with Independent Bank for a line of credit in the amount of \$400,000. Annualized interest of 2.90% is charged on the outstanding balance at the end of each month. The line of credit is secured by cetificates of deposit.

On December 15, 2012 the Corporation entered in a loan agreement with Ford Credit in the amount of \$28,383. The purpose of the loan was to finance the purchase of a 2012 Ford Super Duty F-250 truck. The loan requires monthly payments of \$540 beginning January 29, 2012 for a period of five years. Payments include an interest rate of 5.24%. There was no balance outstanding as of December 31, 2012.
