**MOTION TO REMAND TO COMMISSION**

*TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE OF THE STATE OFFICE OF  
ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS:*

COMES NOW, North Collin Special Utility District ("NCSUD"), and files this Agreed  
Motion to Remand to Commission.

**I. BACKGROUND**

1. On October 18, 2016, Altoga Water Supply Corporation ("Altoga") and North  
Collin Special Utility District ("NCSUD") filed an application for the sale, transfer or merger  
of facilities and certificate rights held by Altoga in Collin County (the "Application").

2. On December 15, 2016, the City of Princeton ("Princeton") requested a  
contested case hearing regarding the Application.

3. The parties to this proceeding reached a settlement of all issues in dispute. A  
copy of the Settlement Agreement was filed by NCSUD on December 5, 2017 (Commission  
Automated Interchange [AIS] Item No. 38).

4. As part of the Settlement Agreement, Princeton agreed to withdraw its  
opposition to the Application.

## **II. MOTION FOR REMAND**

The Commission staff, NCSUD and Altoga have agreed to this Motion.


A copy of this Motion was furnished to legal counsel for Princeton on January 8, 2018. As of the date of filing this Motion, counsel for Princeton has not indicated whether Princeton supports or opposes this Motion. As noted, however, Princeton has agreed to withdraw its opposition to the Application.

There is no remaining opposition to the Application, and there are no issues in controversy. Therefore, NCSUD respectfully requests the Administrative Law Judge to remand this docket to the Commission for processing as an uncontested matter in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

NCSUD respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with this Motion. Specifically, NCSUD requests that an order remanding this matter to the Commission be entered.


