SOAH ORDER NO. 9 REMANDING CASE TO COMMISSION AND DISMISSING CASE FROM SOAH'S DOCKET

On December 5, 2017, the North Collin Special Utility District (District) filed a Notice of Settlement and attached a copy of a settlement agreement signed by all parties except Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) staff (Staff). On January 18, 2018, the District filed a motion to remand this case to the Commission. The District indicated Staff and the Altoga Water Supply Corporation agreed to the motion, but that the City of Princeton (Princeton), which opposed the application and requested a hearing on this matter, had not indicated whether or not it was agreed or opposed. The motion did not request that any evidence be admitted. The time for filing a response to the motion to remand has passed. Princeton signed the settlement agreement filed in this case and filed no response to the motion to remand, indicating to the ALJ that no contested issues remain.

Because no issues are contested by the parties, the ALJ **GRANTS** the motion to remand. **REMANDS** the case to the Commission, and **DISMISSES** the case from the docket of the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
