

I recommend that the Commission make the changes described below to the order

Four new findings of fact should be added after finding of fact 47 under a new heading entitled "Certificates." The new findings of fact should address the cancellation of Altoga Water Supply Corporation's certificate of convenience and necessity number 12580 and to clarify the procedural history related to the certificates. All subsequent findings of fact should

be renumbered.

adopted by the Commission.

- FOF Altoga has sold all of its water systems and will no longer provide service.
- FOF Altoga has no further need for CCN number 12580; therefore, it should be cancelled.
- FOF On March 6, 2019, the Commission ALJ filed an order requiring Commission Staff to file an amended CCN number 11035 for North Collin SUD.
- FOF On March 11, 2019, Commission Staff filed an amended CCN number 11035 for North Collin SUD.

All of the ordering paragraphs should be replaced with the following ordering paragraphs in order to conform the order to the current style used by the Commission.

- 1. The Commission approves North Collin SUD's purchase of Altoga WSC's water systems identified in this Order and operated under water CCN number 12580.
- 2. The Commission amends North Collin SUD's CCN number 11035 to include the area described by this Order and shown on the map attached to this Order.

- 3. The Commission grants the certificate attached to this Order.
- 4. The Commission cancels Altoga WSC's CCN number 12580.
- 5. North Collin SUD must serve every customer and applicant for service within the approved area under water CCN number 11035 that requests water service and meets the terms of North Collin SUD's water service, and such service will be continuous and adequate.
- 6. North Collin SUD must comply with the recording requirements in TWC § 13.257(r) and (s) for the area in Collin County affected by the application.
- 7. North Collin SUD must submit to the Commission evidence of the recording no later than 30 days after the recording required by ordering paragraph 6.
- 8. The Commission denies all other motions and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not expressly granted.

Finally, I propose delegating to the Office of Policy and Docket Management staff the authority to modify the order to conform to the *Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas* and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.

I look forward to discussing this matter with you at the open meeting.
