Tariff Control No. 46460 – Application of T & W Water Service for a Pass-Through Rate Change

NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses T&W Water Service's application for a pass-through rate increase due to an increase in pumpage, import, and surface water fees assessed on the utility by the San Jacinto River Authority. The proposed pass-through rate increase affects all of T&W's customers. The proposed effective date for the rate change is December 1, 2016.

November 8, 2016, Commission Staff recommended that the application and notice be deemed sufficient and further that the application be approved; as specified in the pleading and attached memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended approval of a pass-through rate of \$2.81 per 1,000 gallons for all of T&W's customers, effective December 1, 2016. Commission Staff provided revised tariff pages for T&W.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, T&W's application is sufficient and it is approved. A new pass through rate of \$2.81 per 1,000 gallons for service rendered as of December 1, 2016 is approved. The rate change affects all of T&W's customers. The approved revised tariff pages are attached to this Notice.

PURCHASED WATER/UNDERGROUND WATER DISTRICT FEE PASS THROUGH

PROVISION CLAUSE: For Utilities subject to changes in costs imposed by any non-affiliated provider of purchased water or sewer or a groundwater conservation district having jurisdiction over the Utility, these increases (decreases) shall be passed through as an adjustment to the gallonage charge according to the formula:

AG = G + B/(1-L), Where:

AG = adjusted gallonage charge, rounded to nearest one cent

G = approved gallonage charge, per 1,000 gallons

B = changed in fee (per 1,000 gallons)

L = water or sewer line loss for preceding 12 months, not to exceed 0.15 (15%)

To implement or modify the Purchased Water/Underground Water District Fee, the utility must comply with all notice and other requirements of 30 TAC 24.21 (l).
