**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT AND COMPLETE;
FINDING PROPOSED NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING NOTICE; AND
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation on notice and sufficiency of the application of Wiedenfeld Water Works, Inc. and SWWC Utilities, Inc. dba Water Services, Inc. for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Kendall, Kerr, and Medina Counties.

I. Administrative Completeness

On November 28, 2016, Commission Staff recommended the application be deemed administratively complete. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed administratively complete.

II. Notice

Commission Staff also recommended that the applicants provide notice consistent with the memorandum attached to Staff's filing. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the applicants shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's filing and consistent with the criteria outlined in the memorandum of Leila Guerrero and Gary Horton, using the forms attached to the memorandum. The applicants shall file an affidavit evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.


III. Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket. The following procedural schedule shall apply:

Deadline for applicants to file affidavits of mailed and published notice	January 6, 2017
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of the applicants filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
