**ORDER NO. 2
DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application of Orbit Systems to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity in Brazoria County. Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed administratively complete and that the applicant be required to provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date.

The application is deemed sufficient and administratively complete. The applicant shall provide notice consistent with Commission Staff's December 1, 2016 pleading and as specified in the memorandum of Greg Charles and Gary Horton of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the attached forms. The applicant shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.

The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted. Staff shall propose an additional procedural schedule and/or make a supplemental recommendation upon completion of notice.


