NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THEIR CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CCN) FOR PROVISION OF WATER SERVICE IN BRAZORIA COUNTY, TEXAS

Orbit Systems, Inc. has submitted an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend CCN No. 11982 to provide water service in Brazoria County.

The proposed utility area is located within approximately 5 miles southeast of downtown <u>Angleton, Texas</u>, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>County Road 224</u>; on the east by <u>County Road 420</u>; on the south by <u>0.4 miles south of County Road 224</u>; and on the west by <u>0.9 miles east of FM 523</u>.

The total area being requested includes approximately $\underline{70}$ acres and $\underline{0}$ current customers.

See enclosed map of the proposed service area.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Persons who wish to intervene or comment should write the:

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed service area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed service area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to

the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All requests to opt out of the requested service area must include a large scale map and a metes and bounds description of the tract of land.

Persons who meet the requirements to opt out, and wish to request this option should file the required documents with the:
