## ORDER NO. 5 REQUIRING RESPONSE FROM APPLICANT

This Order addresses Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of the application. Commission Staff stated the application remains deficient and recommended dismissal because after several attempts to cure the application, the deficiencies remain extensive, as listed in paragraphs 1-7 of the memorandum of Fred Bednarski and Greg Charles, of the Water Utility Regulation Division.

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), an application is not considered filed until the Commission makes a determination of administrative completeness; thus, at this time, the application is not considered filed with the Commission. The application is deemed deficient and incomplete.

The applicant shall have until May 31, 2017 to amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. If the applicant is not able to cure the deficiencies, the applicant may file a status report or withdraw the application, if necessary.

Commission's Staff's motion to dismiss will remain pending.
