

FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS DEFICIENT AND INCOMPLETE;
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES

This Order addresses the sufficiency of Riverside Waste Water Treatment Plant's application. Commission Staff recommended that the application is deficient as specified in the memorandum of Andrew Novak and Patricia Garcia of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), an application is not considered filed until the Commission makes a determination of administrative completeness; thus, at this time, the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

The application is deemed deficient and incomplete. On or before March 28, 2017, applicant shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. On or before April 28, 2017, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
