ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's December 9, 2016 recommendations regarding the City of Lucas's application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) no. 10193 in Collin County. Commission Staff recommended that Lucas's application and notice should be deemed administratively incomplete for the reasons specified in the pleading and the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis and Gary Horton in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff also recommended deadlines for Lucas to cure the identified deficiencies and for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Lucas' application and notice are deemed administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **January 13, 2017**, Lucas shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **February 14, 2017**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
