RE: Application for Crest Water Company to Implement a Pass-Through Rate Change for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12037 in Johnson, Ellis, Hill, and Somervell Counties

To whom it may concern:

Enclosed please find the following notice for implementing a pass-through provision as a minor tariff change for Crest Water Company's current tariff. This provision is to pass-through to affected customers water use fees charged by the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District. The following items are enclosed to support the noticed increase:

- 1. Copy of letter from Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District identifying its jurisdiction of Crest Water Company along with monthly fee payment instructions identifying the current water use fee of \$0.20 per 1,000 gallons.
- 2. Copy of the notice to be mailed to all affected customers upon PUC approval.
- 3. Email from Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District summarizing the gallons of water used and the amount paid by Crest Water Company during the 12 month period from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 along with monthly water usage reports.
- 4. Crest Water Company summary identifying the gallons pumped and gallons billed to customers during the same 12 month period used to calculate line loss.
- 5. Copy of Crest Water Company's existing tariff that will change if this application is approved.

Mr. Dewinne,

Thank you for your call inquiring about the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District and its jurisdiction over the water systems owned and operated by your client, Crest Water Company.

The District was created by the Texas Legislature in 2009, with authority to regulate the drilling and operation of water wells and manage the aquifers located in Ellis, Hill, Johnson, and Somervell counties. So, to the extent that your client has water wells that are located in one of those four counties, they are subject to the jurisdiction of the District. The District's legal authority comes from Chapter 8855 of the Texas Special Districts Local Laws Code and Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code.

The District's board of directors adopted temporary rules in 2010 to implement its statutory authority that, among other things, govern the registration of water wells, metering, reporting and water use fee payment requirements. Under those temporary rules, any public water system that can produce 25 gallons per minute or more of groundwater through a single well or through a combination of wells tied to the same system, is subject to the well registration, metering, reporting, and water use fee payment requirements. The vast majority of public water systems and other well owners subject to these requirements have complied with the District's rules requirements without incident. In the unfortunate circumstance where compliance becomes an issue, the District enforces its rules through the enforcement process set out in detail in the rules, which can include assessment of civil penalties and injunctions through a district court, and assessment of attorney's fees, among others.

You also inquired about notice. Notice of the creation of the District was accomplished by the Texas Legislature in 2008 before the bill creating the District was introduced in the Legislature, which included working with the four counties' commissioners' courts and newspaper publication of notice in the four counties. The District's rules and all amendments to those rules were adopted only after publication of

newspaper notice and posting notice as required by law. The District also made numerous additional public relations efforts in 2009 and 2010 to get the word out to water well owners in the four counties about the creation of the District and the adoption of the rules.

The District also sends out reminder statements each year to all registered well owners subject to the water use fee payment and reporting requirements about the rate approved by the board and relevant, deadlines for submission of fee payments and production reports. The District also sends out notices of violation to registered well owners who fail to timely make fee payments or to timely submit production reports.

## MONTHLY FEE PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

#### Prairielands pricing is \$0.20 per 1,000 gallons used.

**Payment Calculation:** 

For the monthly reporting period, take metered usage, divide by 1,000; then multiply by .20.

(Example: If usage is 10 million gallons, calculate as  $10,000,000 \div 1,000 = 10,000 \times .20 = $2,000$ )

For water systems that meet requirements of the District Rule 2.3, a 3% water reduction can be claimed.

# NOTICE OF PASS THROUGH RATE PROVISION INCREASE

Hereby notifies you that it is implementing a pass-through rate provision as part of its water utility tariff on file with the Texas Public Utility Commission (PUC). There will be an increase in the gallonage rate by **\$0.23 per 1000 gallons** for your subdivision. This tariff revision is to recognize changes in water use pumping fees charged by the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District in Ellis, Hill, Johnson and Somervell counties. This tariff change is being implemented in accordance with the minor tariff changes allowed by 16 Texas Administrative Code §24.21. The cost to you as a result of this change will not exceed the costs charged to your utility.

Adjusted Gallonage Rate (AG) = G + [B / (1 - L)], Where:

AG = adjusted gallonage charge, rounded to the nearest one cent;

G = approved gallonage charge, per 1,000 gallons;

B = change in fee (per 1,000 gallons);

L = water or sewer line loss for preceding 12 months, not to exceed 0.15 (15%)

Line Loss Calculation:

Line loss = (Gallons pumped – Gallons billed) / Gallons pumped = (78,653,800 – 69,214,000) / (78,653,800) = (9,439,800) / (78,653,800) = (0.120) or **12%** 

The proposed rates will apply to all service rendered after the effective date and will be reflected on the bill you receive approximately 30 to 45 days after the effective date.

Attached are 2 pages of the report showing water usage for Crest Water. Following, are the dates and amount paid:

- July 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 = 47,700,309 (amount paid \$9,540.06)
- January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016 = 35,158,100 (amount paid \$7,031.62)

We do not invoice our customers. They are responsible for their own reporting based on their meter readings and paying on time. However, emails are sent as reminders as the payment date is approaching. If a customer has not paid on time, additional emails are sent to inform them of past due, or certified mail is sent, if necessary.
