**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION COMPLETE AND ACCEPTED; REQUIRING

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation on sufficiency of the application, provision of notice, and procedural schedule for continued processing regarding the application of Lannius Municipal Utility District and Bois D'Arc Municipal Utility District for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Fannin County.

**I. Administrative Completeness**

On January 6, 2017, Commission Staff recommended the application be found administratively complete and accepted for filing. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is administratively complete and accepted for filing.

**II. Notice**

Commission Staff also recommended that applicants provide notice consistent with the memorandum attached to Commission Staff's filing. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the applicants shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's filing and consistent with the criteria outlined in the memorandum of Jonathan Ramirez and Kristy Nguyen, using the forms attached to the memorandum. The applicants shall file an affidavit evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.
