SOAH ORDER NO. 1 NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND ADMITTING INTERVENOR

On December 13, 2016, the City of Justin (City) filed a Notice of Intent to Provide Water Service to Land Decertified from Aqua Texas, Inc. (Aqua). In the filing, the City notified the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) that it seeks to provide retail water service to an approximate 64.732 acre tract of land that is in the northern portion of an approximately 138.907 acre tract of land decertified from Aqua's CCN by the Commission in Docket No. 45341.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to Texas Water Code Chapter 13.¹ The Commission referred this case to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) on December 19, 2016, requesting the assignment of an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) to conduct a hearing and issue a proposal for decision (PFD), if necessary. SOAH has jurisdiction over matters relating to the conduct of the hearing in these proceedings pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2003.049. In its referral order, the Commission stated it would consider and possibly adopt a preliminary order in the January 26, 2017, open meeting.

I. NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE
